To the Keel Fleet Scoring Committee and PHRF Board Members:

The PHRF Handicap Committee met in a closed meeting in the AYC office at 7 PM on June 23, 2009. The following members were present:

The ratings of the J-27 and Viper 640 were being reviewed in this quarter. After discussion the handicap of the Viper 640 was adjusted from a rating of 96 to a new rating of 102. This was in response to ratings being used in other areas of the country. The J-27 rating was adjusted from a rating of 117 to a new rating of 120. This rating was adjusted using data from J-29 boats in other areas of the country as a baseline. These rating change decisions were unanimous, with Claude Welles abstaining from voting due to having a boat that competes against the boats being reviewed.

In addition, applications were considered for a Ross 830, a Catalina 22 Sport, and a Pearson 26. These boats had no modifications and were assigned their official ratings as previously determined. A table of the assigned ratings is presented below.

The meeting was adjourned at 8 PM.
