

# NOTICE OF RACE

## Austin Yacht Club

### 2014 Turnback Canyon Regatta

1. **RULES** - The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The 2013-2016 Racing Rules of Sailing, (RRS) and the Sailing Instructions.
2. **ADVERTISING** – Advertising will be restricted to Category C.
3. **ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**
  - 3.1. Austin Yacht Club ("AYC") members, guests and non-member competitors are cordially invited to participate in AYC's 2014 Turnback Canyon Regatta. AYC is both the Host and the Organizing Authority of the Series.
  - 3.2. The regatta is open to all mono-hull keelboats, multihull boats (including 'beach cats') and centerboard boats.
  - 3.3. Early Registration discount of \$5.00 closes 5/19/2014 at midnight. Late registration can be done from Tuesday May 20 until Friday May 23 at 12:00 pm online. On-site registration can be done Friday, May 23, 2014 from 5:00 until 7:00pm and Saturday morning from 08:00 until 09:00am. All competitors who have registered online must check in Saturday morning to pick up regatta package, sign liability waiver, and pay any charges not charged to an AYC account or Credit Card. Cash and check will be accepted. Credit Card charges will be through online registration using Paypal.

5. **SCHEDULE**

  - 5.2. All classes will have two (2) race on 5/24/14 and one (1) race on 5/25/14.

6. **SOCIAL ACTIVITIES** – Complimentary breakfast will be served from 8:00 AM until 9:30 AM Saturday

morning. The focus of the 2014 Turnback Canyon Regatta will be the party to be held at the AYC Clubhouse Saturday afternoon and evening. Festivities will begin at approximately 5:30pm with the Lime Drop Steel Band beginning to play. The Fish Fry will be served between 6:00 and 7:30PM. There will be a Dessert Contest and entries should be submitted prior to 5:00 PM with the judging being held before dinner is served. Contest Rules will be available prior to the Regatta. The Steel Band will play until 7:30 PM and be followed by the Shoal Brothers with Wade Bingaman. All participants will need to purchase a wristband, available for \$20.00 each. One wristband is included with regatta registration for all classes. At the end of the race on Sunday, a hamburger lunch will be available for purchase as well as beer, tea and lemonade.

7. MEASUREMENTS - No measurement of boats is required. Any boats competing in a PHRF handicap fleet must have a valid handicap-rating certificate on file with AYC or have submitted a PHRF request to the AYC PHRF Committee.
8. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS - The sailing instructions are available on the AYC website and will be published in the regatta booklet available to all competitors at check-in. One set will be provided to each registered boat.
9. VENUE - AYC is a private yacht club located on Lake Travis, Texas, at 5906 Beacon Drive, Austin, TX 78734-1428. Directions and other information relating to AYC are available on its website located at [www.austinyachtclub.net](http://www.austinyachtclub.net). Please note that neither pets nor fireworks are allowed on club property
10. THE COURSES – Three separate racing events will take place. For keelboats, multihull and centerboard boats, the Saturday race will consist of two long distance races in the vicinity of AYC and racing towards Lakeway, followed closely by a second race returning to AYC. The courses will be adjusted so all boats will be finished by the time the party begins. Overnight moorage will be provided at no additional cost for non-member participants. On Sunday, one long distance race will be conducted, starting and finishing in the vicinity of AYC. Courses will be defined by LCRA channel markers, AYC permanent buoys and/or temporary inflatable tetrahedrons at the discretion of the race committee. For Optimist dinghies, a separate course will be set both Saturday and Sunday using inflatable marks near the vicinity of AYC.
11. SCORING
  - 11.1. All boats will be assigned a Class for scoring purposes. Such class assignments will be posted on the official notice board. Each boat will be scored using her sail number.
  - 11.2. Method of scoring the series will be announced at the competitors meeting and documented on the Order of starts card displayed on the Race Committees Official Notice Board located under the clubhouse. The Keel Handicap fleets will be scored using the “Time on Time” variant of the PHRF rating system in accordance with the Lake Travis PHRF handicap values. The Multihull fleet will be scored under the Portsmouth handicap rating system using US Sailing’s 2008 Portsmouth Yardstick.
12. RADIO COMMUNICATION - A boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones. Race Committee will be available on VHF Channel 78 for any emergency radio messages.
13. PRIZES – Trophies will be determined based upon the number of boats registered at the close of early registration, and awarded according to the fleet designations set by the Race Committee.:
14. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY - Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority, its officers, committee persons, members, or any associates thereof will not accept any liability for and are in no way liable for any material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the Series.
