



NOTICE OF REGATTA
& SAILING INSTRUCTIONS
“CHAPARRAL DE MAR”

October 6, 2019

HOSTED BY ENSIGN FLEET 30

1. ELIGIBILITY:

1.1. The helmsman of each competing yacht shall be considered the “CHAPARRAL DE MAR” Competitor (“Old Salt”). The Competitor must be 70 years old or older, be a current or former AYC member, or a family member of a current AYC member and must have sailed as a racing skipper.

1.2. Competitors are divided into two Classes.

1. “OLD SALT” Junior Class, ages 70 to 74 year old, competes for wine and bragging rights.
2. “OLD SALT” Senior Class, ages 75 and up, competes for wine and the perpetual trophy kept in the AYC trophy case.

2. BOATS AND SAILS:

- 2.1. Each Competitor will be provided an Ensign and a qualified crew to sail in the Regatta.
- 2.2. The boat will be fully rigged and ready to sail.
- 2.3. The Competitor may request to bring additional crew aboard. The decision to allow additional crew will be at the discretion of the Boat Owner and the Regatta Chair.
- 2.4. Boat assignments are designated by the Regatta Chair.
- 2.5. Any limitation on use of sails will be discussed at the skippers meeting. The Regatta Chair’s word will be final.
- 2.6. Only Ensign Sailboats will be used in this regatta.

3. RACE AND RULES:

- 3.1. The Regatta will be embedded in the INDIAN SUMMER SERIES #5 Race and will be conducted using the 2019 INDIAN SUMMER SERIES SI and the Duty Race Committee.
- 3.2. The regatta will use the Ensign start in the INDIAN SUMMER ORDER OF STARTS.
- 3.3. One completed race will constitute a Regatta.
- 3.4. The event will be sailed under the 2017-2020 US Sailing The Racing Rules of Sailing and the Ensign Class Association Rules.

3.5. The minimum number of crew shall be two sailors in addition to the skipper, and the maximum number of crew shall be four sailors in addition to the skipper.

4. COURSE:

4.1. The course will be a Long Distance Course selected from the AYC 2018 COURSE CARD and will be announced at the Skippers Meeting. It will also be posted on the stern towers of the Race Committee Boat. (This modifies the INDIAN SUMMER SERIES SAILING INSTRUCTIONS).

5. SCORING:

5.1. Scoring will be in accordance with the Low Point scoring system of Appendix A of The Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020.

5.2. Each boat will be scored using its sail number.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:

6.1. Sailing Instructions will be the AYC INDIAN SUMMER SERIES SAILING INSTRUCTIONS except as modified by section 4.1 of this document.

7. REGISTRATON & ENTRY FEE:

7.1. Registration is required. No registration will be accepted after 6:00 pm, Friday, October 4. There is a limited number of boats available and boats are committed on a first registered, first awarded basis. Early registration is encouraged and appreciated.

7.2. **Old Salts may register by contacting the Regatta Chair, Fred Ford via email or txt and stating their desire to race.** There is no regatta Entry Fee. A voluntary donation of \$25.00 (Twenty-five) dollars to the AYC FUND is suggested.

8. TROPHY:

8.1. The perpetual trophy will be awarded. In addition, the winner of each division will receive a celebratory bottle of wine.

8.2. Awards and additional recognition will be made at the post-race Refreshments and Trophy Presentation at the AYC Clubhouse.

9. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS:
