



NOTICE OF RACE

August 2019 DragonFlite 95 Regatta

1. RULES

1.1. The Series will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing for 2017-2020, (RRS), including Appendix E, Radio Sailing Racing Rules, and the DragonFlite 95 Restricted Class Rules (DF95-RCR), with exceptions as listed in this Notice and the Sailing Instructions.

1.2. Class Rules

1.2.1. All boats will comply with the latest DragonFlite 95 Restricted Class Rules (DF95-RCR) as published on the www.dragonflite95.us website.

1.2.2. All boats are subject to checks for compliance with the DF95-RCR.

1.2.3. Sail Identification: As per the latest DF 95- RCR. The diagram provided by the DF95 USA Class Association in these class rules is advisory but remains correct and shall replace RRS, Appendix E8 (Identification of Sails).

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

2.1. Austin Yacht Club's DragonFlite 95 Fleet cordially invites you to attend the 2019 DragonFlite 95 Summer Regatta to be held at Austin Yacht Club on Saturday, August 10, 2019 beginning at 1:30pm. Austin Yacht Club is a private yacht club, located on Lake Travis at 5906 Beacon Drive, Austin, TX 78734.

2.2. This is an open one-design regatta for DragonFlite 95 model boats (Radio Controlled). Only "A" rigs will be used in this regatta.

3. ENTRY AND FEES AND PARKING

3.1. All competitors are requested to pre-register by emailing Claudia Bartlett at claudia.bartlett@gmail.com with your name, address, club affiliation, sail number, and phone number prior to August 9, 2019 at 5:00 pm.

3.2 Registration will be held from 12:00 pm to 12:30 pm under the AYC clubhouse. The registration fee is \$20 per boat, (cash only please). Registration forms will be available. The entry fee includes beer, soda, and prizes for the regatta.

3.3 Each competitor will be required to sign a waiver of liability.

3.3 Boats must check-in prior to the first signal of the day, at the Competitor's Briefing at 1:00 pm at the Rylander Pavilion in the South Cove.

3.4 Parking on the AYC Point in front of the Rylander Pavilion is permitted, but PLEASE park in an orderly, head-in, manner.

4. SCHEDULE

1. Races will be held using the Promotion/Relegation Scoring System as described in the American Model Yacht Association Heat Management System (HMS) 2014. Boats will initially be seeded into A and B Fleets by the Race Officer. No races will be started after 6:00pm.
- 4.2 Courses will be described and diagrammed at the Competitor's Briefing.

5. REFRESHMENTS/SOCIAL ACTIVITIES – Refreshments will be available following the racing. Competitors are encouraged to join other Class competitors at a local restaurant after the races to explain their racing strategies, successes, or why they were denied their rightful place on the podium after the racing.

6. MEASUREMENTS - No measurement of boats is required.

7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS – Sailing Instructions will be available at Registration. One set will be provided to each registered boat.

8. VENUE – AYC is a private yacht club located on Lake Travis, Texas, 5906 Beacon Drive, Austin, TX 78734.

8.1 Directions and other information relating to AYC are available on its website located at www.austinyachtclub.net

8.2 Please note that neither pets, fireworks, nor drones are allowed on club property.

8.3 Launching/Retrieving – Boats may be launched/retrieved at the Rylander Pavilion.

8.4 AYC is committed to prevent the spread of invasive species, and asks all boat owners, whether sailboats, motorboats, or kayaks, to clean their bilges and their trailers when coming from another lake to Lake Travis, and when leaving Lake Travis headed to another lake. <https://www.texasinvasives.org/https://www.texasinvasives.org/>.

9. AWARDS - Trophies will be awarded to helmspersons in accordance to the overall size of their respective Fleets as follows:

- 9.1. 2-3 entries 1 trophy
- 9.2. 4-6 entries 2 trophies
- 9.3. 7-10 entries 3 trophies

To the fullest extent permitted under Texas law, each boat owner, skipper and crew unconditionally and irrevocably release and discharges the Austin Yacht Club, their Officers, Board of Directors, agents, the Organizing Authority, and all other persons who assist in maintaining equipment or in organizing and/or conducting races from all claims and legal liability for personal injury, death or property damage incurred in connection with the event.
