Dog Days Series started June 16th, with a 5:30pm start. The sailing conditions have been excellent for the first two weekends. We have averaged 36 boats on the line, a little bit down from the last series, but still good considering the summer vacation season is on. Although we only have meals scheduled for June 20 & End of Series, there seems to be fleet-led activities each week. Like the old days, lots of fun.

We will rectify this with a short checklist on each boat, and a "shutdown sheet" for each chase boat/RC boat.
