Registration for the spring season of the Junior Program is up. So far we have 29 sailors registered, and I expect that number to be at 40 by the start of the season.

Summer Camps and PB&J registrations are up as well, with registration numbers higher than last year at this point. Our summer program flyers will be included in the Nurture My Child Camp Fair bags that they give out to the first 200 attendees. Since the fair is on Opening Day, we will not be attending like we have the past few years. On March 5, Carolyn will be at the West Austin Chamber of Commerce Camp Fair, with an opti, passing out information to interested parties. Our summer program flyers will also be included in the first 200 bags given out at this event.

Steve Gay taught a US Sailing Level 1 Course here the past two weekends, with 7 attendees, 5 of which were from AYC.

I have my summer camp staff set for this year, although I still have open spots for CIT's. CIT's need to be at least 14 years old, and at least an intermediate level sailor, comfortable sailing an FJ in strong winds.

On Opening Day this year, instead of an Un-Regatta, we will be racing FJ's to Sometimes Island and back. This is a free event, open to all sailors. Registration is on the AYC website. It is free to sign up but it is required that people register so that we have a waiver for the event.

Scott Young, John Morran, and Matt Romberg are hosting a clinic for the junior sailors on Saturday, March 3rd. This clinic is free to all sailors registered for the spring season, and a \$25 charge for all other participants.
